1. The Tournament Committee

Tournament Director: Sławomir Piński

Head Referee: Krzysztof Góra

The Tournament Committee will issue local rules before the start of the tournament. The tournament is played in accordance with the "General Regulations of PGA Poland Tournaments" and Hard Card PGA Poland.

UNITY LINE PRO-AM Szczecin Open will be played on 17 May 2026 on the golf course of Binowo Park Golf Club..

2. Eligible to play

a. Pro Players

b. Amateurs: Players with both active and inactive handicap will be allowed to play. Players without an active handicap will not be included in the net standings. Players' maximum exact handicap – 36.0

The tournament limit is set at 120 players. The order of applications is decisive, provided that the entry fee is paid within SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE START OF THE TOURNAMENT

3. Entries for the tournament

Teams for ProAm must be registered by e-mail, but e-mail registration of a team is not tantamount to the registration of a player. Each competitor is obliged to register individually via the website www.szczecinopen.com. Applications are accepted until May 10, 2026.

The tournament's amateur limit is set at 60 players. The order of applications is decisive, provided that the entry fee is paid within SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE START OF THE TOURNAMENT.

4. Tournament format

The team at Pro-Amie consists of a minimum of 2, and a maximum of 3 amateurs and 1 PRO. The Pro-Am tournament is played on eighteen holes in the better ball stroke play net format. The sum of the two best results from each hole counts for the classification. Tournament starts on the shotgun

Each team must give back two scorecards. Otherwise, the result will not be counted and the team will be disqualified

5. Tee

Professionals:

a. women: yellow, 5441 m,

b. men: white, 6013 m,

Amateurs:

a. Women and juniors up to the age of 12: red, 4530 m, taking into account the length changes allowed by the European Golf Federation (EGA)

c. men and juniors over 12: yellow 5441 m, taking into account the length changes allowed by the European Golf Federation (EGA)

Amateurs in the Pro-Am Tournament can play a round of tee for professional players, men - white, women - yellow. An amateur who decides to play with a professional tee must report it to the tournament director before the game starts. Changing the tee during the round is forbidden

6. Fees

- a. Club members – 250 pln
- b. Club Guests - 450 pln
- c. Club Juniors – 190 pln
- d. PRO and Non Am - no fee
- e. Juniors outside the club – 360 pln

7. Awards

During the PRO-AM, the best three teams will be awarded

The failure to award a prize by an amateur is tantamount to its loss. In-kind prizes that will not be collected during the award ceremony will be transferred to an additional competition during the final of the cycle - PGA Polska Championship.

8. Draws

In the case of equal results, the countback will be decisive in the following order: better results on the last 9, 6, 3, 1 holes. The "last 9 holes" is understood as holes 10-18 of the field.

9. Personal data

According to the polish law art. 13 para. 1 and par. 2 GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation. Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (general regulation on data protection) of April 27, 2016 (Journal of Laws of EU, No. 119), we would like to inform you that:

1. The administrator of personal data of Tournament participants is the Association of Golf Instructors PGA Poland with headquarters in Warsaw 00-067, Al. Jerozolimskie 65/79, email biuro@pgapolska.com, contact telephone: 506875558

2. Personal data of the Athletes, such as: name, email address, telephone number, provided as part of the registration form will be processed by the Organizer to the extent necessary to conduct the Tournament, in particular in order to complete the application process and confirm the Player's participation in Tournament, announcement of results, distribution of prizes, consideration of possible complaints / claims made in connection with participation in the Tournament.

3. If the Athlete agrees, his personal data, in the areas referred to in point 1, shall also be processed by the Organizer in order to send the Athlete information and commercial information of the Organizer's partners.

4. Each participant of the Tournament agrees to take photographs, free use of the image in the film, photo and audiovisual materials prepared by the Tournament Committee or by an entity authorized by the Tournament Committee. Consent to the free use of the tournament participant's image includes multiple use of the tournament participant's image for promotional, marketing, advertising and publishing purposes.

5. The personal data of the Tournament participants will be used in accordance with the conditions set out in the GDPR Regulation, Polish regulations adopted in order to enable the application of the GDPR, other applicable laws and these Regulations.
6. The controller of personal data does not transmit data to a third country / international organization. Personal data of participants will not be subject to automated processing, including profiling.
7. The basis for the processing of personal data of the Tournament participants is art. 6 par. 1 letter b) GDPR - performance of the contract (acceptance of the Regulations and registration of participation in the Tournament constitutes the conclusion of the contract) and art. 6 par. 1 lit. a) GDPR - voluntary, unambiguous, informed and specific consent of the data subject.
8. Tournament participants have the right to access their data and the right to rectify, delete, limit the processing, the right to data transfer, the right to raise objections, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the legality of processing, which was made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing that was made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
9. Participants of the Tournament have the right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Body when the Participant considers that the processing of his personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
10. Providing personal data and consenting to their processing is voluntary, but their failure or lack of consent to their processing prevents participation in the Tournament. Making a notification is tantamount to accepting the rules contained in the Regulations of the event and giving consent to the processing of personal data. In the case of a minor, consent to the processing of personal data must be expressed by the person having parental authority or legal guardian.
11. The processing of data in connection with participation in the Tournament includes in particular:
 - a. reminder about paying a fee for participation in the tournament by phone or email
 - b. the publication on the website of the Floating Garden Szczecin Open Tournament of the name and surname of the participant on the tournament start list along with the start times
 - c. the publication on the website of the Floating Garden Szczecin Open Tournament of the name and surname on the tournament score list
